What is a healthy God-honoring marriage?

A healthy God-honoring marriage involves a man and a women, not two men or two women.

because they exchanged the truth about God for a lie and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever! Amen. For this reason God gave them up to dishonorable passions. For their women exchanged natural relations for those that are contrary to nature; and the men likewise gave up natural relations with women and were consumed with passion for one another, men committing shameless acts with men and receiving in themselves the due penalty for their error. Romans 1:25–27 (ESV)

A healthy God-honoring marriage involves a marriage, not just <u>living together</u>.

Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and they shall become one flesh. Genesis 2:24 (ESV)

A healthy God-honoring marriage involves a husband and wife that understand their <u>God-given</u> roles.

A husband and wife are of <u>equal</u> importance and value before God.

So God created man in his own image, <u>in the image of God he</u> <u>created him; male and female he created them</u>. Genesis 1:27 (ESV)

A husband and wife play different roles in marriage.

"Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh." This mystery is profound. and I am saying that it refers to Christ and the church. Ephesians 5:31–32 (ESV)

God-given marital roles are not <u>arbitrary</u> or <u>reversible</u>. Sin twisted marital roles.

<u>Your desire shall be for your husband</u>, and <u>he shall rule over you</u>." Genesis 3:16 (ESV)

A wife's marital role is to <u>submit</u> and <u>support</u> her husband, just as the church submits to Christ.

Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. For the husband is the head of the wife even as Christ is the head of the church, his body, and is himself its Savior. Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit in everything to their husbands. Ephesians 5:22–24 (ESV)

A husband's marital role is to <u>love</u> and <u>sacrifice</u> <u>his life</u> for his wife, like Christ loved the church.

Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her, that he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, so that he might present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish. In the same way husbands should love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself. For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ does the church, because we are members of his body. Ephesians 5:25–30 (ESV)
