## The Beginning of Victory over Temptation


- 1. Repent of blame shifting.

James 1:13-14 - The Blame Game

A trial is what I experience on the <u>outside</u> of my life, temptation to sin is what I experience on the <u>inside</u> of my life.

The most important thing someone can pray for me in a trial is not <u>release from the trial</u> but not <u>giving in</u> to the temptation of the trial.

# Every trial offers one of two paths.



Trials → Testing → Steadfastness → Completeness + Maturity

Trials → Temptation → Sin → Death

Then <u>Satan stood against Israel and incited</u> <u>David to number Israel</u>. 1 Chronicles 21:1 (ESV)

#### What about Job?

# What about Jesus' temptation in the wilderness?

Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil.

Matthew 4:1 (ESV)

# My sin is my fault.

But each person is tempted when he is lured and enticed by his own desire. James 1:14

(ESV)

# Will I ever face temptation that is too strong to resist?

No <u>temptation</u> has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and <u>he will not let you be tempted beyond your ability</u>, but with the <u>temptation</u> he will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it. 1 Corinthians 10:13 (ESV)

## Playing the Blame Game is a dead end road.



The man said, "The woman whom you gave to be with me, she gave me fruit of the tree, and I ate." Genesis 3:12 (ESV)

Then the Lord God said to the woman, "What is this that you have done?" The woman said, "The serpent deceived me, and I ate." Genesis 3:13 (ESV)

We ultimately blame <u>God</u> for our sin.

Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am being tempted by God,"... James 1:13 (ESV)

God can not be tempted, therefore, he can not <u>tempt</u>.

...for God cannot be tempted with evil, and he himself tempts no one. James 1:13 (ESV)

This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all. 1 John 1:5 (ESV)

For it was indeed fitting that we should have such a high priest, <u>holy, innocent, unstained, separated from sinners, and exalted above the heavens</u>. Hebrews 7:26 (ESV)

What about times when it looks like God is behind <u>temptation</u>?

Didn't <u>God</u> incite David to number Israel?

Again the anger of the Lord was kindled against Israel, and <u>he incited David against them</u>, saying, "Go, number Israel and Judah." 2 Samuel 24:1 (ESV)
